Theatre Rhinoceros presents *Darebnb*

Theatre Rhinoceros presents *Darebnb*, a comedy about housing in San Francisco, for four shows only at SparkArts in The Castro.

John Fisher (Playwright) is the recipient of six Bay Area Theatre Critics Circle Awards for playwriting and directing and is the only two-time winner of the Will Glickman Award for playwriting (*Medea*, *the Musical* and *Combat!*), given by the Bay Area's major critics. He recently appeared in New York City at the United Solo Festival in his one-man show *A History of World War II*, for which he won the Best Actor Award. He will perform this show at The Marsh in San Francisco in the Fall and at Pangea Nightclub in Manhattan in September. In 2016 John competed with himself for Best Actor as a Bay Area Theatre Critics Circle Award nominee for both *Breaking the Code* and *Shakespeare Goes to War*. Other recognitions include two Cable Car Awards for Best Production, the GLAAD Media Award and the *LA Weekly* Award for Best Los Angeles Theatre, the *SF Bay Guardian* Goldie Award and the *BackstageWest* Award. John holds a PhD from UC Berkeley and has taught acting, directing and playwriting at UC Berkeley, UC Santa Cruz, A.C.T., and in the MFA Playwriting Program at the Yale School of Drama. www.JohnFisher.biz
